

SALARY ADJUSTMENT

We have been advised today by Statistics Canada that the Industrial Aggregate is 1.8%.

The salaries of prothonotaries will therefore be increased by 1.8% as of April 1, 2016 as provided for under section 25 of the *Judges Act*.
